Lower School and Sixth Form Uniform Requirements 2019

Located within the Cloisters, in the centre of the school, LASS (the School Shop) is the sole supplier of Benenden uniform and sportswear.

Uniform fittings for new pupils are carried out by appointment only – these take approximately 1½ hours. Appointments are available Monday to Friday during term time. LASS is also open for uniform fittings between Monday 8 July and Wednesday 31 July 2019 and from Tuesday 27 August 2019. Uniform fittings are not available on a Saturday.

Please note appointments on New Pupils' Days (14 June - 11+/12+ and 21 June - 13+) and from 27 August are reserved for overseas students.

Payment must be made in full at your appointment. LASS accepts payment by cash and most major credit/debit cards. A price list is available on request.

LASS operates a second-hand uniform service. Subject to availability, these items can be seen and purchased at the time of your appointment.

Naming

All uniform, home clothing, bedding and towels should be clearly labelled with sew-in nametapes. Nametapes should show the student's full name and House initial (E,G,H,M,MA,N). LASS is able to pre-order sew-in nametapes for clothing and it highly recommends that, where possible, these are ordered a minimum of 3 weeks in advance of your appointment in order for them to be ready for collection at your fitting. LASS recommends 288 nametapes for a full uniform and home clothes. A supply of nametapes should be left with your daughter's Matron for naming any uniform purchased during term time. All other items should be clearly named appropriately.

LASS offers a nametape sewing service (chargeable and for LASS purchases only). This service is subject to availability.

Trunks and tuck boxes should be clearly marked with the student's name and House initial. LASS is able to order self-adhesive naming strips for trunks and tuck boxes and it is advisable that, where possible, these are ordered in advance for collection at your appointment. Trunks and tuck boxes are also available to purchase through LASS.

Books

All required class text books will be ordered for students by subject Teachers and charges will appear on the subsequent bill. A student planner and a supply of paper will be issued.

Mouthguards

All girls who play lacrosse or hockey are required to have a properly fitted mouthguard to protect their teeth. The Medical Officers of Schools Association sees danger in ill-fitting self-applied mouthguards and we advise that to conform to the requirements of the sports authority, mouthguards should be individually fitted by a reputable dental technician after the mould has been made by a dental practitioner. Alternatively, on the first Saturday of the Autumn Term, we arrange for a company who use dentists to attend, if you prefer a mouthguard to be fitted at school.

Bed Linen

The school provides duvets, pillows and bed linen but pupils may prefer to provide their own duvet covers. These must be polyester-cotton, colour-fast and machine washable. No silk, corduroy or pure cotton bed linen is allowed as it is not possible to launder these in school.

We prefer pupils not to bring their own sheets as the school provides these. Any personal sheets must not be white so as to be able to identify which belong to the school.
